Johnson & Wales University offers Early Action Admission, a non-binding application program for students who view JWU as one of their top-choice schools. Along with a decision letter, the applicant will receive scholarship notification (if applicable). Application and transcripts must be received by the deadline. Candidates for Early Action will be evaluated primarily on their high school record through their junior year. Students who apply but do not meet the deadline will be placed in the regular admission applicant pool.

Applications for the Fall Semester received after November 1 will be reviewed on a rolling basis; Admissions will begin releasing decisions in mid-December.
